Improve Accessibility and Workflow

The process begins and ends with the patient chart, the centerpiece of each patient's care. Often practices struggle with keeping charts up to date or finding charts when they're needed. With Intergy EHR, a digital chart enables you to combine newly generated clinical information, incoming data such as diagnostic studies and discharge summaries, and existing paper chart content into a single electronic chart. A configurable summary page allows you to select preferred clinical data elements such as medication history and test results, displaying a snapshot of the patient's medical record in one view. The addition of the obstetric chart into the mix makes chart management even more complex in the paper world, but with Intergy EHR, managing a separate but integrated OB Chart is as easy as clicking a button.

Streamline Documentation, Ordering and Ongoing Care

The high patient volume in OB/Gyn requires efficiency in treatment planning and documentation. Structured clinical documentation and customizable templates allow you to comprehensively document the encounter and improve coding. You can also complete the visit by electronically ordering diagnostic tests, scheduling surgery, submitting prescriptions and documenting required follow up. Health Management tools can be set up to provide guidelines for preventive and ongoing care for conditions from cervical health to pregnancy to menopause. Clinical flowsheets make it possible to quickly review information across patient visits. For example, a flowsheet can instantly provide analysis of a patient's response to Hormone Replacement Therapy.
